



Ministry Fund-Raising Policy

The UU Church of the Restoration Ministries are encouraged to raise additional funding to increase their program finances and the actual fund-raising activity is left up to the discretion of the Ministry involved with adherence to the following restrictions.

1. Any fund-raising event plans must be discussed and approved by the Ministry Council prior to advertising the function.
2. Fund-raising activities must be outward-facing (i.e. intentionally be aimed at the community rather than just at the congregation) – and must be paid for from the available individual Ministry funds. This includes paper and postage.
3. Profits from any fund-raising event must be divided in the following manner:
60% of the profit is to be kept by the Ministry for its operating costs,
20% goes to a combined Ministry pool,
20% is given to the Church's general income.
4. Sexton services must be arranged for by the Ministry in advance if the event is held on church property. The Church sexton should be given the right of first refusal if professional services are required for setup or cleanup.

The Council is advised to be prudent about the number and spacing of such fund-raising events and to be mindful of wear and tear on church facilities.
