Last Year's Empty Plate Dinner

- Over 400 people attended
- 70 local restaurants donated food
- Local artists and students hand-painted 400 plates
- Event Sponsors included Bryn Mawr Trust, Councilman Bobby Henon, & State Representative Jared Solomon
- Each year, we raise over \$10,000 to support PIHN families

PIHN in 2018

- Sheltered and relocated 21 families to stable housing
- Prevented homelessness and eviction for 57 households
- Engaged volunteers in over 15,000 hours of activity
 - Provided material supports for 425 families (1000+ individuals)



PIHN's Core Values

- We keep families together. Family members are not sent to separate shelters
- More than 90% of families never require another shelter stay
- 40% of families pursue higher education after their time in our program
- Continued follow-up and support leads to long term success
- We work to prevent homelessness before it begins
