Indigenous Peoples Day Philly(IPD Philly) will be holding its annual Indigenous Peoples Day gathering on Monday, October 11 at Shackamaxon Park, otherwise known as Penns Treaty Park, located near the waterfront in the Fishtown neighborhood. The gathering will be held from 11 am to 5 pm. In February 2021, Mayor Kenney signed an executive order making the second Monday in October as Indigenous Peoples' Day replacing the city's previous marking of Columbus Day on this date.

IDP Philly's mission is to cultivate an active Native American / Indigenous presence in the city of Philadelphia through cultural, educational and community-building initiatives that uplift our Native traditions, creative economies, and histories.
